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Having fun making marks, drawing or writing



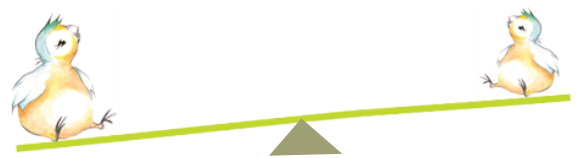
Pointing out signs or logos when you're out or at home

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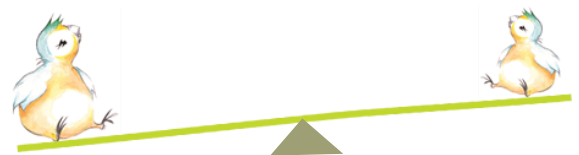
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
